with its purpose: -sell, mortgage, lease, transfer, or otherwise dispose of its property by any lawful means;

-elect its Congregation Council, boards, and committees, and require them to carry out their duties in accordance with the constitution, bylaws, and continuing resolutions; and

k .- terminate its relationship with the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America as provided in Chapter 6.

\*C5.04. This congregation shall choose from among its voting members laypersons to serve as voting members of the Synod Assembly as well as persons to represent it at meetings of any conference, cluster, coalition,

or other area subdivision of which it is a member. The number of persons to be elected by the congregation and other qualifications shall be as prescribed in guidelines established by the \_Sierra Pacific Synod of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America.

The voting membership of the Congregation Council shall consist of the pastor(s) and not more than twelve nor fewer than nine members of the congregation. Any voting member of the congregation may be elected, subject only to the limitation on the length of continuous service permitted in that office. A member's place on the Congregation Council shall be declared vacant if the member a) ceases to be a voting member

of this congregation or b) is absent from four successive regular meetings of the Congregation Council without cause or c) resigns from his/her Council seat. Consistent with the laws of the state in which this congregation is incorporated, the congregation may adopt procedures for the removal of a member of the Congregation Council in other

The members of the Congregation Council except the pastor(s) shall be elected by written ballot to serve for three years or until their successors are elected. Such members shall be eligible to serve no more than two full terms consecutively. Elections shall be held at a legally called meeting of the congregation during the month of May.
